



## What is it?

뭐예요?

뭐 ('what') + ~예요 (is equals to)  
= 뭐예요? (What is it?)

To answer 'What is it?' you simply attach either ~이에요 [i-e-yo] or ~예요 [ye-yo] to a noun to make the sentence 'It's a (noun).'

~이에요 is attached if the noun ends in a consonant.

~예요 is attached if the noun ends in a vowel.

### Example Sentences

뭐예요? [mwo-ye-yo?]  
= What is it?

바나나예요. [ba-na-na-ye-yo]  
= It's a banana.

가방이에요. [ga-bang-i-e-yo]  
= It's a bag.

사과예요. [sa-gwa-ye-yo]  
= It's an apple.

물이에요. [mu-ri-e-yo]  
= It's water.
